- 8. Ability to provide skilled nursing care, set priorities, and make judgements in the community health setting.
- 9. Work with staff members to provide program support for various nursing and health department programs as directed.
- 10. Responds to public health emergencies as required by the department or division administration; carries provided mobile phone, or other emergency communication devices during all work hours and at all other times when unavailable by phone at home.
- 11. Participate in health clinics and fairs to promote the Parents as Teachers program.
