### ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Provide personal transportation to meet Health Educators across the district.
- Age requirement: 16 to 20 years old, possessing a valid driver's license or actively pursuing one.
- Must pass a Bureau of Criminal Investigation check.
- Maintain open and accurate communication with the supervisor.
- Uphold strict confidentiality in all aspects of compliance checks and related tobacco activities.
- Execute duties as a decoy, including requesting tobacco product purchases, presenting valid identification, and liaising with law enforcement concerning clerk interactions.
- Communicate effectively and truthfully about activities within retail establishments.
- Attend court proceedings if required and provide testimony on tobacco compliance check details.
- Participate in decoy training sessions.
- Support community events.
- Distribute health education materials.
- Assist in observational surveys.
- Collaborate with health educators to develop health promotion campaigns.
